Barbara Bell Stewart, 65, Harrison

Barbara Bell Stewart passed peacefully into her next life on Tuesday morning, Dec. 8 (2009).

Barbara was born in Evansville, Ind., on May 23, 1944, to Marguerite and Gerard Bell, who eventually settled in Sherman Oaks, Calif., where Barbara attended and graduated from U.S. Grant High School.

In her 65 years, Barbara led an adventurous life. As a young mother, she and her first husband left Los Angeles, Calif. and moved to the mountains of Wicks, Mont. As recently as 2003, Barbara reminisced about that brief time in her life, calling it "a great adventure."

Later in life, she eventually settled in Harrison with her second husband, Charles Stewart. There, she and Charles owned and operated The Whistle Factory, which made and sold wooden novelty toys to gift shops throughout the country. In her later years, Barbara worked as a market research specialist for MarketLauncher, Inc., where she developed an expertise at conducting interviews with key executives in the fields of architecture and engineering design.

She retired in 2008 and from there, focused her full attention on her great love: breeding, raising and showing oicats. Known in the show cat world as one of the preeminent experts on the oiccat breed, Barbara produced numerous champions and grand champions throughout her career.

As recently as Sept. 10 (2009) Barbara wrote, "I really have enjoyed having oiccats for the past 23 years, and they have brought a lot of good into my life. I got to go to Sweden because of them and also have people from all over the world come here to pick cats from me."

In 2008, Barbara fulfilled her dream of a lifetime and visited Kenya, Africa, on a photo safari. Barbara was amazed by all that she saw on this trip and was planning to return as soon as possible.

Barbara is survived by her sister, Cindy Marclese; her daughters, Leeann Smithyman of the Washington, D.C. area and Lara Triozzi of Orlando, Fla.; her son, Paul Stewart of Harrison; and seven grandchildren. All will miss her very much.
